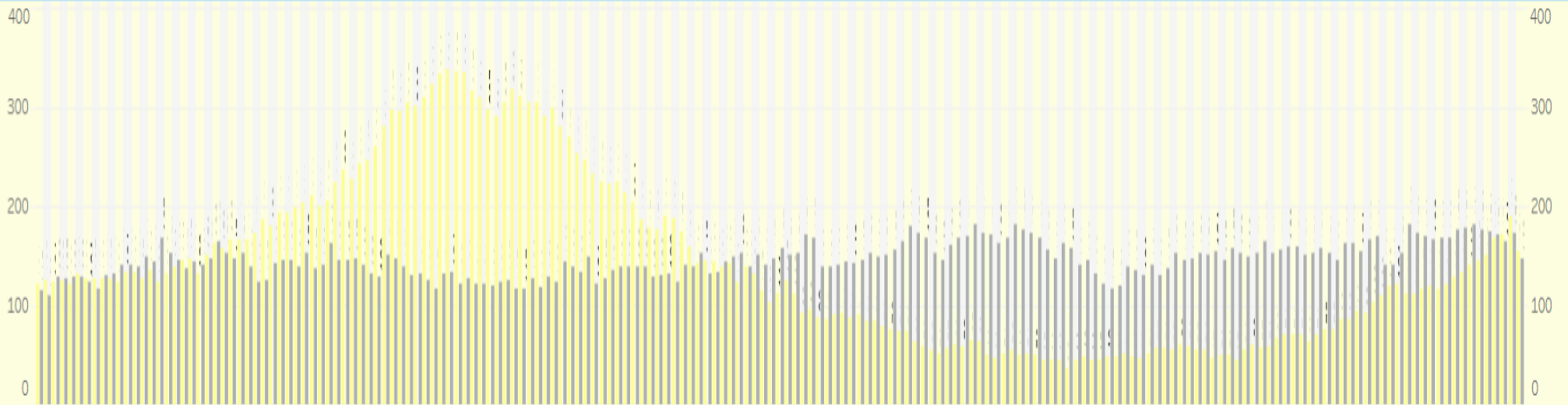

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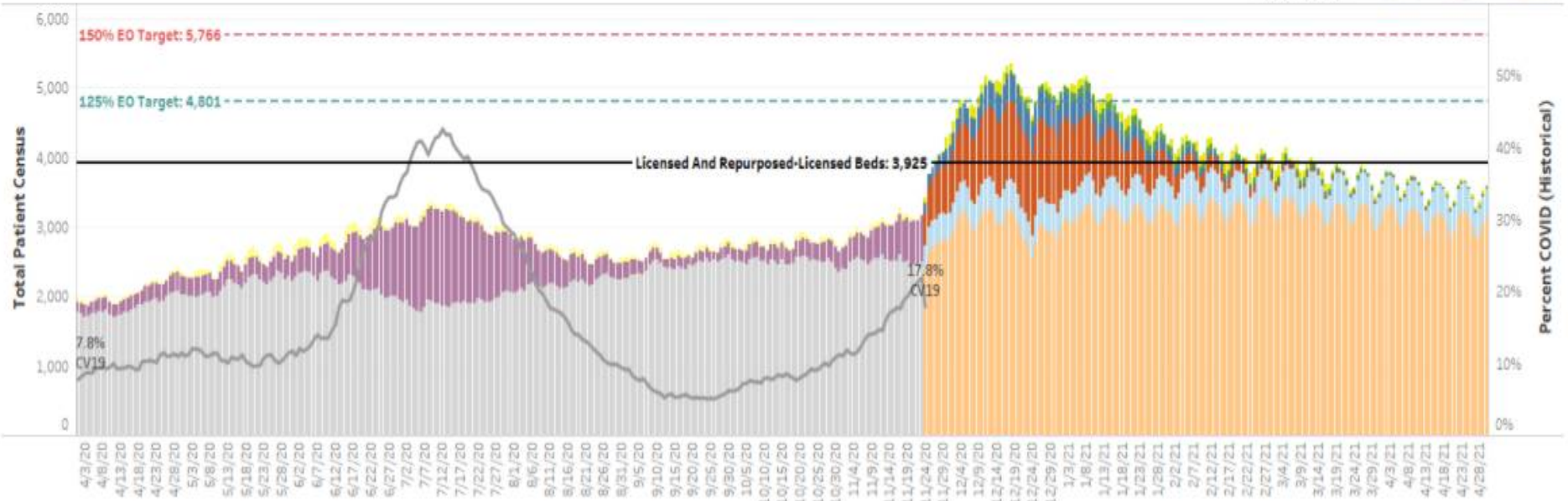

- Visitation modified

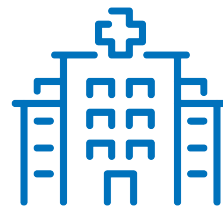

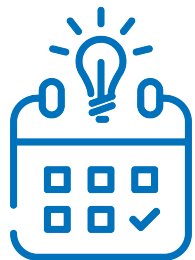

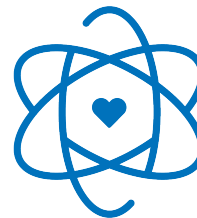

Vaccine and treatment



- bamlanivimab, Eli Lilly monoclonal antibody, available in limited supplies for COVID+ non-hospitalized patients who meet additional criteria
 - Infusions began last week
 - Patients over the age of 18 with possible COVID may be evaluated at a Banner Urgent Care or Banner Health Clinic to see if they may qualify
 - Appointments for Banner Urgent Care can be done online at [bannerhealth.com](https://www.bannerhealth.com)
- Regeneron monoclonal antibody received EUA from FDA. Banner will communicate when we become aware of when drug will become available and how we will make it available to patients
- Our pharmacy team is evaluating new combination treatment of baricitinib and remdesivir for COVID treatment and will provide risk/benefit guidance

Vaccine Updates

- What we are doing:
 - Committed to distribution at State Fairgrounds, Banner Del Webb and Banner University Medical Center – Tucson campus
 - Preparing to identify individuals in top tier (health care workers and first responders)
 - Preparing to safely handle the vaccine with its cold storage requirements
 - Preparing to document vaccine given and remind individuals to return for 2nd dose
 - Committed to being ready by mid-December if vaccine arrives
 - Working collaboratively in all states and counties



HOLIDAY SAFETY: At home



Limit gatherings to immediate family if possible

If more than one household gathering, consider:

- Being outdoors
- Self-isolation 10-14 days prior to gathering
 - If high risk family members present, consider everyone being tested prior to gathering
- Zoom game time with extended family and friends
