The Journal of the Plague Year archive was created to collect COVID-19 stories. Its mission is to preserve these stories for future generations so they can gain insight into the experiences of those who lived through a global pandemic. Submissions can be in a variety of forms such as social media posts, news articles, text, photos and memes.



Indigenous stories align with the Journal of the Plague Year mission to represent pandemic experiences from all races and ethnicities. Although the archive has collected many Indigenous stories, the majority are from the media's point of view, not from tribal members themselves. The archive welcomes the voices of Indigenous tribes and invites them to submit stories describing their personal COVID-19 experiences.
