**Step 2:**

The target audience for this call is healthcare workers (doctors, nurses, etc. in a hospital setting and EMS professionals in private or municipal settings) spanning a wide range of employers. The two best options to reach the target audience are an official human resources e-mail for hospital settings (contact with HR in individual hospitals, or networks would be necessary and contact of individual municipal departments would also be necessary) and social media groups of medical professionals. The launching of the campaign could begin immediately (beginning Monday, June 15).
